

### **Christmas Baskets 2024**



First Presbyterian Church has partnered with St. Vincent de Paul and the Catholic Community for over 40 years (47, I believe) to provide food and gifts to families at Christmas. This year we will be using the former CAL Ranch building (655 E. Anderson, behind Fred Meyer).

We held our one day of interviews with clients on November 9th at the Holy Rosary parish hall and ended up with just over 200 families (our target for this year). The Giving Tree is up in the library. If you are able, please take a tag or two, purchase the suggested items for the child and return the unwrapped gifts to the church. Please return gifts as soon as possible, but NLT the date indicated on the tag.

Like the last few years, we will be following procedures that reduce the number of volunteers in the building at any one time (and the number of volunteers available seems to decrease each year). So, we will <u>not</u> be wrapping gifts and will provide gift cards for kids 13 and older. If you wish, you may donate wrapping paper that will be provided with the unwrapped gifts on Distribution Day. We will reduce the number of food items in the boxes and there will be no "re-packaging" of food (e.g., rice, dry beans, potatoes, fruit). We will not distribute bread, margarine, or eggs on Distribution Day. We will supplement the food boxes with grocery gift cards. The supply of turkeys this year (and space to store them) is uncertain but we are looking at sources for turkeys or gift cards for turkeys so please <u>do not</u> purchase turkeys for the project. Because we will be providing gift cards to the families, monetary donations are important this year.

Just write a check to the church with Christmas Baskets on the memo line. We will not be able to distribute bikes again this year. Our move-in day for the building will be the Saturday <u>before</u> Thanksgiving, November 23rd starting at 9AM at St. Vincent de Paul 805 S. Holmes; we can use help if you are able.

<u>Distribution Day is December 14<sup>th</sup></u> (volunteers should arrive by 8:30). Rather than publishing a general schedule, we will be sending emails or Realm notices or calling smaller groups to help with specific tasks. Look for more information in the coming weeks.

As always, your support is very much appreciated as we work together to provide much-needed food and gifts to families in need.
